The UCLG Forum on Intermediary Cities is a consultation and policy development process that culminates in an event every two years.

The Forum process is led by the City of Chefchouen and supported by a core structure of pilot IntermediaryCities:

Odienné in the Ivory Coast for Africa Nevsehir in Turkey for Middle East & West Asia Terrassa in Spain for Europe Cuenca in Ecuador for Latin America

Objectives of the Forum

The Forum should produce policy guidance related to the constituency represented there in and should foster visibility for the issue of intermediary cities. It will provide instruments for cities and mayors to support vertical and horizontal dialogue, as well as policies to facilitate the implementation of the SDGs and global agendas, through their social, cultural, urban and financial dimensions.

This mission requires an instrument to follow-up and monitor the actions and challenges of this implementation and its dynamics in intermediary cities at a global scale. This instrument is the World Forum of Intermediary Cities.

In addition to this monitoring role, the Forum will further address the need to generate coherent and comprehensive governance of the implementation of the global agendas through the localization of the New Urban Agenda.
